Call to order/Welcome

**Review of School Policies:**

**I. Family-School Compact**

- Masterman goals-question about why only middle school student grades referenced and not high school. This is based on a SDP anchor goal. Melanie will look into this further and will explore the feasibility of including high school students in the stated goals.
- School/teacher responsibilities: the question was raised if we should add any language reflecting the option of virtual meetings between teachers and parents. Melanie noted this point and stated different schools have chosen to address this differently.
- Parent responsibilities: consider using the term "family" instead of parent throughout the document. Melanie will take this question back to grants compliance monitor.
- Consider using the term "students" instead of children.
- Student health and well-being should also be a responsibility of the teachers and staff.
- Student responsibilities are "encouraged" but not compulsory.

**II. Family Engagement Policy**

- Annual Title I meeting held in conjunction with Back to School Night early in the school year.
- Budget meeting: could not present to SAC directly this year but sent out via email to SAC members. Ms. Brown did a budget presentation for staff. Consider presenting the budget at an H.S.A. meeting.
- Consider making the Title I parent interest survey available on the Masterman website to increase response rate.

- Mention parents' having access to school computers, printers, library resources, etc. Suggestion was made that the school and H.S.A. work together to compile a list of parent resources and work together to spread the word out to the family community.
